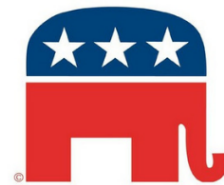
Special Report Platforms PA

Move from Carbon Fuels, Mandate Clean Energy: The Platform calls for a complete restructuring of the U. S. economy through a shift to all clean energy, federal spending, and a commitment to using union labor with robust wage requirements. (DNC Platform, Pages 49-55)

Projected Impact: The costs of doing business and federal tax burden will increase, while employment and economic growth will suffer in the short term, when it's needed most.

Reduce Regulations: The RNC Platform calls for a reduction in Federal regulations. (America First Agenda)

Projected Impact: Small businesses and the overall economy will be strengthened, however the impact of this will be seen over time.
